Call Summary

February 2016

- 2/8/2016 Personnel responded to a residence on Barnacle Row for a report of a person that had fallen from a ladder. Upon arrival the crew found a male patient seated in a vehicle who had fallen from approximately 30 feet. Patient assessment was conducted and the patient's injuries were determined to be non-life threatening. EMS was advised and the patient was packaged for transport to a local trauma center. All units returned to service.
- 2/10/2016 Personnel responded to a residence on Morgan's Cove Court for a report of a smell of smoke in the home. Upon arrival there were no signs of smoke or fire visible and crews began to investigate. After a thorough investigation crews were able to trace the source of the smoke to a freezer motor with an arcing relay. The power to the freezer was secured and all units returned to service.
- 2/21/2016 Personnel responded to a report of an outside fire on the beach behind Grand Pavilion. Upon arrival the crew found a small pile wood that was smoldering from an apparent bon fire. The fire was extinguished and all units returned to service.
- 2/24/2016 Personnel responded to Breach Inlet after receiving reports of debris washing ashore. Numerous pieces of boat wreckage were found, collected, and brought to Station No. 1. Personnel from the Charleston County Sheriff's Office and the U.S. Coast Guard conducted a search of the waters around both islands and off-shore for any other signs of a boating mishap. Nothing was found. Personnel continued to collect debris during subsequent shifts.
- 2/26/2016 Personnel responded to a residence on Palm Boulevard for a possible structure fire. Upon arrival crews found smoke visible from the top floor of a 4-story home. Crews conducted a quick search for the source of the smoke while others gathered information from the homeowner. The homeowner said he turned on the stove, heard a loud pop, saw flames in the stove, and the house began to fill up with smoke. Further investigation revealed the fire had extinguished itself and crews began to open windows to provide natural ventilation. Once the home was clear of smoke all units returned to service.


