Case Synopsis

August 17 – Monday

Fraud: 7600 Palmetto Drive. The complainant stated she wired money to rent a condo using Craigslist and arrived to find the entire transaction was fraudulent.

August 18 - Tuesday

Grand Larceny: 2400 block of Cameron Boulevard. The complainant stated her relatives pawned several household electronics from her rental house while they were staying there. Most items were recovered but the victim is unsure as to pursuing charges.

August 19 – Wednesday

Grand Larceny: 100 block of Charleston Boulevard. Patrol officers arrested a housekeeper who turned herself in after admitting she stole several jewelry items from the homeowner back in March 2015.

August 21 – Friday

Theft From a Motor Vehicle: Back Court. The complainant stated unknown subject(s) removed a beach accessible wheelchair from the back of a parked truck. The complainant waited a week to report the missing wheelchair, hoping it would be returned.
