Case Synopsis

January 26: Monday

Burglary: Seaside Cottage Lane. The property manager discovered three televisions missing from inside the rental residence, which was found to be unsecured. Three televisions were taken from this same property in February 2014. Total value of the recent theft is \$941.23.

Fraud: 30th Avenue. The victim stated unknown subject(s) debited his checking account fraudulently in the amount of \$525 via Western Union online. Another declined transfer was attempted in the amount of \$545. The successful transfer went to a location in New Jersey.

February 1: Sunday

Petit Larceny: Palm Boulevard. The complainant stated unknown subject(s) removed three traffic reflectors from the state easement in front of his residence. Value \$15.

Vandalism: Cameron Boulevard. The complainant stated his mailbox was damaged by unknown means, most likely struck by a vehicle that left the scene. Value \$100.
