Case Synopsis

March 10, Tuesday

Burglary: 1100 block of Ocean Boulevard. A witness reported a suspicious male leaving the rear of the closed business holding an apparent cash drawer, then jumping over a fence. Officers responded and located an unsecured rear door and discovered the petty cash drawer missing (estimated cash total \$150).

March 11, Wednesday

Vandalism: Intracoastal Court. The complainant stated an acquaintance has been using her dock without her permission, causing damage to it. The complainant wished only to have the subject placed on trespass notice for her property.

March 12, Thursday

Petit Larceny: 500 block of Carolina Boulevard. The complainant stated while doing landscaping work at the location a Stihl leaf blower was discovered missing from the landscaping trailer parked along the street. Value \$350.

Petit Larceny: 1100 block of Ocean Boulevard. The restaurant manager stated a couple left without paying their tab (\$40) after they were refused further service due to the fact that they were too intoxicated.
