Case Synopsis

December 29: Monday

Burglary: Beachside Drive. The complainant reported a 55” television of unknown make missing from inside the residence. There were no signs of forced entry. The missing television was originally reported by the cleaning crew. Another television was reported missing from the same residence in November.
