Call Summary

February 2010

- 2/17/10 Personnel responded to report of a fire alarm activated on 44th Avenue. Upon arrival crew found residence filled with light colored smoke. After speaking with the resident the source apparently was a fireplace with a closed damper, discoloring the bricks above the glass fireplace doors. Personnel opened the damper, doors and upstairs windows as well as set up of a fan at the back door to ventilate the building. Thermal imager was utilized on bricks and surrounding walls to check temperature. Once the smoke was removed all personnel cleared the scene.
- 2/26/10 Personnel responded to a missing person call. Missing person, who has a history of Alzheimer's left home for an errand and had not returned. Fire Department checked the Marina Market, the Kangaroo Gas Station as well as Waterway Boulevard and surrounding streets. Missing person was located by the Police Department in the area of 27th Avenue.

Additional Training

All career personnel continued their Rapid Intervention Team training. Additional training was done on personal protective equipment and water supply.

Medical in-service training covered CPR recertification for all career personnel.

All volunteer personnel continued their Rapid Intervention Team training and received training on new fire attack nozzles that will be placed on the apparatus.

Retired Assistant Chief John "Skip" Coleman of the Toledo (OH) Fire Department presented an all-day seminar to each of the shifts and several volunteers entitled "Street-Smart Fire Officer." Each session talked about different methods and procedures being employed throughout the country.

Lieutenant Roger Eagle successfully completed the Instructor Orientation Workshop for the Basic Aerial Operations course. His next step to become an instructor in the program is to complete an 8-hour apprenticeship through the S.C. Fire Academy.

Firefighter Trevor Speelman completed the Department of Transportation National Registry Basic Emergency Medical Technician course held at the Charleston Naval Weapons Station in Goose Creek.

Firefighter Tripp Walther has begun his Fundamentals of Basic Interior Structural Firefighting course at the Berkeley County Emergency Services Training Center.
