Call Summary

December 2012

- 12/10/12 Personnel responded to a report of a smoke alarm activation at a residence on Ocean Boulevard. Upon arrival units observed visible smoke on the first floor from the exterior. The incident commander saw a pan on the stove producing heavy smoke as he was conducting his size-up and ordered crews to force entry into the building. Personnel shut off the stove and removed the pan from the home. The smoke was removed with a positive pressure ventilation fan. The building was turned back over to the owner and all units returned to service.
- 12/12/12 Personnel responded to a report of a brush fire in the area of Palmetto Drive and Edgewater Alley. Upon arrival crews found a small area of brush burning in the median and pulled a hose line to extinguish the fire. It was determined the fire had been ignited by some brush that was too close to a light fixture. All units returned to service.
- 12/15/12 Personnel responded to a report of a gas can on fire at a residence on Charleston Boulevard. Upon arrival crews observed no signs of smoke or fire and began to investigate. After talking with the homeowner it was determined that the owner's son had poured gasoline on a small pile of yard to debris to burn it and did not leave the gas can a safe distance from the area when the fire was lit. When the pile of debris was lit, the flames ignited the gasoline vapors coming from the gas can and caused the gas can to burn. The fire was extinguished prior to the Fire Department's arrival and no further assistance was needed. All units returned to service.
- 12/24/12 Personnel were called to assist the Awendaw Fire Department with a fire involving a 45-foot boat in the water near McClellanville. Personnel were responding to the area when they were advised by the incident commander that the situation was under control and they could return to their station.

Additional Training

All career personnel received training on fire hose, ground ladders, and fire ground operations.

All volunteer personnel received training on fire hose and self-contained breathing apparatus.

Medical in-service training covered Pharmacology, Patient Assessment, Vehicle Extrication and Special Rescue, and Incident Management.

Battalion Chief Maibach served as an assisting instructor for the S.C. Fire Academy Fireground Simulation course held at the Summerville Fire Department. This two-day class utilized computer simulations to training emergency incident commanders.

Captain Eagle successfully completed a one-day Quarterly Training for Fire Marshal's class. These updates are mandatory to maintain the State Fire Marshal certification.
