Call Summary

November 2013

- 11/16/13 Personnel responded to the docks behind Morgan's Cove Drive for a report of a boat that had sunk. Upon arrival crews determined the boat had sunk hours prior to the Fire Department being notified. The incident commander met with U.S. Coast Guard officials to see what assistance could be provided. Personnel obtained absorbent booms and pads from Fire Station No. 1 and took them to the scene to cover the leaking fuel. The boat owner contacted a private firm to clean up the fuel and remove the boat from the water. All personnel returned to service.
- 11/20/13 Personnel responded to a report of boaters in distress near Dewees Island. Boat 1020 was launched and quickly made contact with a U.S. Coast Guard vessel in the Intracoastal Waterway who was responding to the same incident. Boat 1020 was directed to area near Goat Island, while the Coast Guard continued toward Dewees Island. Fire Department personnel met up with two tug boats that were awaiting the tide change, and neither crew reported being in distress or knowing of anyone else in the area in distress. It was later confirmed the original caller had been making contact with the crews on the tug boats and no one in the area was in need of assistance. All personnel returned to service.
- 11/28/13 Personnel responded to the area of Live Oak Drive for a report of smoke in the area. Originally, crews were directed to the City Marina area, but diverted to Live Oak Drive based on a visual of smoke in the area. After checking around several homes, crew found a pot of cooking grease on fire in the back yard of a residence. The fire was extinguished and all units returned to service.
