Call Summary

October 2013

10/14/13 Personnel responded to the beach in the area of 3400 Palm Boulevard for a report of two dogs and a deer that were in the water. Upon arrival crews launched a jet ski to check on the animals. The animals exited the water on their own. All units were returned to service.

10/19/13 Personnel while on a standby assignment at Awendaw Fire Department Station No. 1 were dispatched to possible structure fire on Zacoma Road in Awendaw. Upon arrival personnel saw no signs of smoke or fire and began to investigate. Upon investigation personnel found the heating element in an oven had broken and caused smoke to fill the residence. The oven was unplugged and all surrounding areas were checked for heat. Nothing further was found. The resident was advised not to use the oven until it had been repaired, all units returned to service.

10/19/13 Personnel responded to a report of a person in distress near Capers Inlet. A jet ski had come loose from it's mooring and an individual trying to recapture it had been swept away from shore by the current. Boat 1020 was launched with a crew from Charleston County EMS on board. The U.S. Coast Guard was contacted about responding a helicopter to the area to aid in the search. Marine resources from the North Charleston Fire Department, Charleston County Rescue Squad, the Charleston County Sheriff's Office, and the S.C. Department of Natural Resources also were enroute. As units were responding, dispatch was contacted by a kayaker who said he found the person in distress and he was bringing him to shore. Through phone contact it was confirmed the individual had been brought to shore and did not need any further assistance.

As the first incident was concluding the Coast Guard contacted Isle of Palms about an 18-foot vessel that had run aground at the north end of Capers Island while it was searching for the original person in distress. Boat 1020 was dispatched to check on the vessel and its occupants. Radio communications with the vessel were difficult. Eventually the Coast Guard was able to make contact with the boater, and they were going to anchor the boat in place and wait for the tide to come in. All units were returned to service.

10/25/13 Personnel responded to a report of a structure fire on Palm Boulevard. Upon arrival crews found smoke showing from the rear of the structure and upon investigation the fire involving an outside deck had been controlled by a passerby with a garden hose. Crews began to overhaul and check for any fire extension. No extension was found and the fire was contained to the point of origin. Power to the swimming pool heater was secured and the immediate area was overhauled thoroughly. The owner was contacted and advised of the situation. All units were returned to service.

10/26/13 Personnel responded to a report of a boater in distress in the Intracoastal Waterway. Units received information that the boat was at Mile Marker 99 and the operator could not find his way back to the boat landing from where he launched. Boat 1020 located the boat and brought both passengers to the City Marina. North Charleston Fire Department Marine 201 arrived on scene and towed the boat back to the marina. After the boaters were evaluated by EMS, they were taken back to the boat ramp where they started at to retrieve their truck and trailer. All units were returned to service.


