Call Summary

September 2013

- 9/2/13 Personnel responded to the area of Bull's Bay to assist the Awendaw Fire District with a report of a missing boater. While enroute Boat 1020 was advised there were five (5) people on board the boat. Prior to reaching their destination, Boat 1020 met the missing boat coming toward the marina. All passengers were fine and the boat required no further assistance. All units returned to service.
- 9/10/13 Personnel responded to the beach access in the 1100 block of Ocean Boulevard for a patient complaining of chest pain. Upon arrival personnel began evaluating the patient whose condition deteriorated rapidly. After several minutes the patient lost consciousness and went in to cardiac arrest. Personnel initiated basic life support protocols and turned patient care over to Charleston County EMS upon their arrival. The patient was transported to a local medical facility where they were declared deceased.
- 9/15/13 Personnel responded to the front beach area for a report of a missing person in the water. Crews initiated a search of the area and began to assemble watercraft for deployment. After a short search of the beach in the area the missing person was found and returned to their family. All units returned to service.
- 9/22/13 Personnel responded to a residence on Wills Way for a report of a structure fire. Upon arrival crews determined the fire had been confined to a grill on the back porch of the residence and the fire was extinguished. Crews checked the porch and the home for any possible fire extension. None was found. All units returned to service.
- 9/27/13 Personnel responded to the docks behind The Boathouse Restaurant for a report of a fire on a boat. Upon arrival crews were met by the caller who led them to the boat. They met with a passenger on the boat who extinguished the fire in the dashboard prior to the fire department's arrival. The batteries were secured by fire department personnel to prevent re-ignition of the fire and the boat's occupant was advised to have a technician check the dashboard before operating the boat again. All units returned to service.
