The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of November, 2013.

## **November 01: Friday**

Warrant Arrest: 2100 block of Palm Boulevard. While patrolling the area of 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue and Palm Boulevard, an Officer observed a seatbelt violation and conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. During the roadside investigation, it was learned that there was an outstanding warrant out of the Berkeley County Sheriff's Office. The subject was placed under arrest.

## **November 03: Sunday**

Petit Larceny: 1000 block of Ocean Boulevard. The complainant advised responding Officers that an unknown suspect(s) stole a surfboard sign from the front of the business.

Burglary: 200 block of Forest Trail. An Officer on patrol observed a suspicious vehicle parked in a residence driveway and upon investigation discovered a burglary in progress. Back-up units responded and a subject was located leaving the residence with several stolen items. The subject was placed under arrest.

## **November 04: Monday**

Traffic Arrest: 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducting patrol of the area observed a vehicle bearing an expired license plate, and conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. The operator of the vehicle advised the Officer that he did not have his driver's license with him and provided false identifying information to the Officer. The subject was placed under arrest and charged with no driver's license, providing false information to a police officer and operating an uninsured vehicle.

## **November 05: Tuesday**

Traffic Arrest: 5700 block of Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle observed to have inoperable equipment. During the roadside investigation, it was determined that the operator did not possess a valid driver's license.

**November 06: Wednesday**

Traffic Arrest: J. C. Long Boulevard and Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducted a traffic stop for a seatbelt violation. During the roadside investigation, it was learned that the operator's license was suspended for failure to pay a traffic fine.

**November 08: Friday**

Traffic/Narcotics Arrest: 2000 block of Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducted a traffic stop for a speeding violation. During the roadside investigation, it was determined the operator of the vehicle's driver's license was suspended for a DUI charge. Further, while speaking with the operator, the Officer observed him to apparently be under the influence of alcohol, detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from within the vehicle and observed several open containers of alcoholic beverages. The operator and passenger were both placed under arrest. While conducting a pre-tow inventory of the vehicle, a green plant-like material (GPM), identified as marijuana was located inside the vehicle. The passenger of the vehicle was additionally charged with simple possession of marijuana.

**November 11: Monday**

Vandalism: 2300 block of Palm Boulevard. The complaint reported that unknown suspect(s) painted two SCE & G electrical boxes preventing the boxes from cooling properly, causing damage to the circuits.

**November 12: Tuesday**

Traffic Arrest/Driving Under Suspension: Palm Boulevard/21<sup>st</sup> Avenue. An Officer conducted a traffic stop for a seatbelt violation. During the roadside investigation, it was learned that the operator's license was suspended.

**November 13: Wednesday**

Traffic Stop/Driving Under Suspension: Palm Boulevard/22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue. An Officer conducted a traffic stop for an equipment violation. During the roadside investigation, it was learned that the operator's license was suspended and had two active bench warrants for failure to pay traffic fines.

Theft From Vehicle: 4th Avenue. The victim advised reporting Officers that unknown suspect(s) entered his unsecured vehicle and stole a handgun.

Theft From Vehicle: 41st Avenue. The victim reported that unknown suspect(s) entered his unsecured vehicle and stole his checkbook.

Traffic Arrest/Driving Under Suspension: 1500 block of Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducted a traffic stop for a seatbelt violation. During the roadside investigation, it was learned that the operator's license was suspended and had one active bench warrant for failure to pay a traffic fine.
