Call Summary

June 2014

- 6/1/14 Personnel responded to a report of a boat with a broken mast floating adrift in Dewees Inlet. Boat 1020 was launched to assist. Information was received that the boat had made it to land near Ocean Point and fire department personnel were dispatched to that location. Personnel did not find the boat or its crew at Ocean Point and contacted them directly. Units proceeded to Shipwatch and did make contact with the boat. The boat was aground on the beach and all passengers were in good condition. No medical treatment was needed. The boat's owner arrived on scene and all units returned to service.
- 6/3/14 Personnel responded to a residence on Palm Boulevard for a report of a water leak. Upon arrival crew found the water service line to the home was leaking at the pump. The pump and the water were shut off, and the occupants were advised to contact the property manager. All units returned to service.
- 6/3/14 Personnel responded to Dewees Marina for a report of a hazardous fluid spill in the water. Upon arrival crew found a boat submerged in water spilling a mix of fuel and oil in the water. Crew placed containment booms around the spill, and notified the U.S. Coast Guard, the Department of Health and Environmental Control, and the Department of Natural Resources. The boat owner could not be reached. When the U.S. Coast Guard arrived they assumed control of the incident, contacted Tow Boat U.S., and made arrangements for the boat to be salvaged. All units returned to service.
- 6/6/14 Personnel responded to beach behind Mariner's Walk for a report of five people in distress on a sandbar. Upon arrival a jet ski was launched to assess the situation. Personnel spoke with everyone on the sandbar and returned them to shore one at a time. No further assistance was needed and all units returned to service.
- 6/14/14 Personnel responded to a dock on Morgan Creek for a report of a boat sinking and leaking fuel. Upon arrival crew found the dry dock had lost air on the port side causing the boat to tip in the direction and allow fuel to leak out. Due to the darkness personnel were unable to estimate approximately how much had spilled. The U.S. Coast Guard was notified and they advised they would send someone out in the morning. A switch was found for the air pump to re-inflate the dry dock, leveling the boat, and stopping the fuel leak. All units returned to service.
- 6/17/14 Personnel responded to Palm Boulevard for a report of a vehicle fire. Upon arrival crew found a storage trailer and a nearby palm tree on fire. Crew quickly extinguished both fires before they could extend any further. All units returned to service.
