Isle of Palms Fire Department
Call Summary
May 2014

- 5/1/14 Personnel responded to Mariner's Walk for a service call. Upon arrival crews found water leaking from an underground pipe servicing the fire sprinkler system. The water was shutoff and a fire watch was established by Wild Dunes Security until the sprinkler company could make the repairs. All units returned to service.
- 5/4/14 Personnel responded to a report of an outside fire at the intersection of 26th Avenue and Cameron Boulevard. Upon arrival crews found a small burned area at the base of an electrical pole. Bystanders had extinguished the fire prior to the Fire Department's arrival. Bystanders said the transformer on the pole had blown and embers fell down onto the vegetation on the ground causing the fire. South Carolina Electric and Gas was notified of the situation and they were going to respond. Once all hazards had been addressed, all units returned to service.
- 5/6/14 Personnel responded to a report of an 8-month-old choking on Surf Lane. Upon arrival the crew found that the patient's grandfather had swept the child's mouth and caused them to spit up the obstruction. The crew assumed patient care from the family, continued to clear and manage the airway until the arrival of EMS. Patient was evaluated and appeared to be fine and patient was transferred to EMS for transport.
- 5/7/14 Personnel responded to a report of a swimmer in distress in the ocean near 23rd Avenue. While enroute crews were advised the swimmer had been removed from the water, unresponsive, and bystanders were performing CPR. Upon arrival crews confirmed CPR was in progress and took over patient care. The patient was placed on a backboard and transported to the medic unit standing by at the 21st Avenue beach access. Patient care was turned over to Charleston County EMS and all units returned to service.
- 5/8/14 Personnel responded to the pier near the Charleston County Park for a report of multiple people trapped under the pier. Upon arrival crews found the Charleston County lifeguard staff had removed one person from under the pier and were attempting to assist several more trapped under the pier. Both crews were able to remove all patients and medical attention for minor cuts and abrasions was provided. One patient was transported to a local medical facility. All units returned to service.

- 5/11/14 Personnel responded to the Isle of Palms Connector for a motor vehicle accident. Upon arrival crews found an accident involving three motor vehicles. One patient was treated for a neck injury and transported to a local medical facility for further care. All units returned to service.
- 5/21/14 Personnel responded to assist the Awendaw Fire Department with a structure fire on Gulf Drive. Upon arrival the crew assisted with fire attack. Once the fire was under control the crew was released and returned to Fire Station No. 1.
- 5/26/14 Personnel responded to the Sea Cabins condominiums for a report of an outside fire. Upon arrival crews found a small fire near the underside of the building and pulled a 1 ¾-inch attack line to extinguish the fire. The crew performed overhaul to ensure all fire had been extinguished. The fire was confined to the pine straw along the building and some damage to the lattice work along the bottom of the building was noted. All units returned to service.




