The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of January.

Friday, January 1

Driving Under the Influence – 52nd Avenue / Palm Boulevard

An Officer stopped a vehicle for multiple moving violations to include speeding, 70 MPH in a posted 55 MPH speed zone. Upon making contact with the driver, the Officer determined that she was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver indicated she had only had one beer. The Officer asked the driver to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Test and at the conclusion of the test, the driver was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for DMT Testing, where she refused to submit a breath sample. The driver was charged with DUI, Open Container, and lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Saturday, January 2

Petit Larceny – 1100 Block Ocean Boulevard

A victim reported that while she was at a local restaurant, she placed her iPhone on the counter to charge and when she went to get it, she realized an unknown person had stolen the phone. The victim was able to provide a serial number for the phone, which was entered into NCIC. The approximate value of the stolen item is \$700. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Traffic Stop/Simple Possession of Marijuana – 41st Avenue

An Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 38 MPH in a posted 25 MPH speed zone. Upon making contact with the driver, the Officer could smell a strong odor of marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. During a search of the vehicle, the officer located drug paraphernalia and a container containing what appeared to be marijuana. The driver was placed under arrest, charged with simple possession of marijuana, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Tuesday, January 5

Driving Under Suspension – IOP Connector

An Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 76 MPH in a posted 55 MPH speed zone. Further investigation revealed that the driver was in possession of a suspended driver's license. The driver was placed under arrest, charged with speeding, and driving under suspension.

Burglary – Seaside Cottage Lane

A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered their residence and stole two televisions. The victim was able to provide serial numbers for the televisions and they were entered into NCIC. The approximate value of the stolen items is \$753. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Wednesday, January 6

Burglary – 4000 Block Cameron Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into her residence, ripping out pages from a personal book and stealing them. The approximate value of the item stolen is \$15. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Saturday, January 9

Disorderly Conduct – 1000 Block Ocean Boulevard

An Officer patrolling the Front Beach area observed a large crowd in the road outside a local establishment. As the Officer got out of the patrol vehicle, people began yelling and pointing at a person in a car, saying he had a knife. The Officer immediately detained the subject identified as having the knife. The subject was determined to be intoxicated, refused to cooperate with the Officer, and was subsequently arrested. Another subject inside the car was determined to be intoxicated and refused to cooperate with the Officer. Both subjects were arrested for Disorderly Conduct/Public Intoxication and lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Wednesday, January 13

Driving Under the Influence – 4300 Block Palm Boulevard

An Officer responded to a call in reference to a possible intoxicated driver. The Officer located the vehicle and stopped the vehicle for multiple moving violations. Contact with the driver determined that she was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver told the Officer she had not been drinking and was on the way home from a work function. The Officer requested the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Test, and at the conclusion of the testing, was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to Mt. Pleasant Police Department for DMT testing, where she provided an incomplete breath sample. The driver was lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Monday, January 18

Driving Under the Influence – Fishers Alley

An Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 51 MPH in a posted 35 MPH speed zone. Upon contact with the driver, it was determined that he was possibly under the influence. When the driver was asked how much he had drank, he replied two beers. The Officer requested the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Test and upon completion was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to IOPPSB for DMT Testing, where the driver refused to provide a breath sample. The driver was lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Credit Card Fraud – 500 Block Palm Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown person(s) used her credit card information to make unauthorized purchases via the internet. The victim was still in possession of her credit card and reported the fraudulent activity to her bank. The approximate amount charged was \$250. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Tuesday, January 19

Driving Under the Influence – 4400 Block Palm Boulevard

An Officer stopped a vehicle for multiple moving violations. Upon contact with the driver, it was determined that he was possibly under the influence. When the driver was asked how much he drank, he said he only had a couple of beers. The Officer requested the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Test and upon completion was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for DMT Testing, where he provided a breath sample that resulted in a .15% BAC. The driver was lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Petit Larceny – 31st Avenue

A victim reported that unknown person(s) stole his son's bicycle from the yard of a residence he was visiting. The approximate value of the stolen item is \$150. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Petit Larceny – 1000 Block Palm Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown person(s) stole his phone that he was shipping back to the service center. The approximate value of the stolen item is \$500. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Wednesday, January 20

Credit Card Fraud – Beachside Drive

A victim reported that unknown person(s) used her name and credit card number to make unauthorized purchases via the internet. The victim was still in possession of her credit card and made proper notification to her bank. The approximate amount charged was \$686. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Sunday, January 24

Credit Card Fraud – Commons Court

A victim reported that unknown person(s) used her credit card information to make unauthorized purchases via the internet. The victim was still in possession of her credit card and reported the activity to her bank. The approximate amount charged was \$414. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Wednesday, January 27

Traffic Offense – 1400 Block Palm Boulevard

An Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 74 MPH in a posted 55 MPH speed zone. Further investigation revealed that the driver was not in possession of a driver's license. The driver was arrested and lodged in the Charleston County Detention Center.

Saturday, January 30

Petit Larceny – Live Oak Drive

A victim reported that unknown person(s) stole her guitar from her residence while she was away. The approximate value of the stolen item is \$2000. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

"Unfounded" – The offense described did not occur or occurred in another jurisdiction.

"Exceptionally Cleared" – (Closed) The case has been cleared due to offender death, lack of prosecution, denied extradition, victim declining prosecution, or offender was a juvenile (no custody).

"Administratively Closed" – (Non-criminal incident or investigation suspended) All available leads have been exhausted, but the case has not been brought to a conclusion, and investigative efforts may be resumed if new evidence or leads are discovered at a later date.


