The City of Isle of Palms wishes to share the following:

Initial damage surveys, based upon post storm street assessments, may be found on the City's website at [www.iop.net](http://www.iop.net), at the top of the page, Hurricane Matthew Updates.

Shoreline damage has not been assessed due to continued high tides.

Access to both Sullivan's Island and Isle of Palms is limited to properly credentialed residents and business owners.

Isle of Palms Water and Sewer Commission indicates that the drinking water quality is excellent.

Power has not been interrupted.

Citizens should avoid storm water in the area of Waterway and 41<sup>st</sup> Avenue and Palmetto Drive and Morgan Place Drive due to potential bacteria contamination.

A curfew is in effect from 8 p.m. until 8 a.m.

Citizens are asked to avoid downed lines due.
