**Coyote Community Forum**

The City of Isle of Palms will host an informational forum about coyotes at **5:30 p.m. on Wednesday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2016** at the Recreation Center located at 24 Twenty-eighth Avenue.

“After a few coyote sightings around the island, we want to offer residents information and action updates” states Mayor Cronin.

“The forum will include experts that can help us better understand and manage coyotes.”

A representative of the South Carolina Department of Natural Resources will talk about the state’s coyote population, their food habits, preferred habitats, breeding activities, and what can be done to control coyotes. The forum will also offer information about control techniques and South Carolina’s regulations.
