

**Isle of Palms Police Department**

Case Synopsis

**PETIT LARCENY.** Palm Boulevard. 01/18/10. A local business reported three beer carts and rails as being stolen from the rear of the business. Through investigation, a suspect has developed. The investigation continues.

**GRAND LARCENY.** Palm Boulevard. 01/18/10. Victim reported jewelry stolen from within the residence. The case is being investigated by the Criminal Investigations Division.

**PETIT LARCENY.** Seascape. 1/18/10. Victim reported securing a bicycle on the bicycle racks on the property. The next day, the victim discovered that unknown person(s) had cut the security chain and taken the bicycle. Through investigation, a suspect has developed. The investigation continues.

**PETIT LARCENY.** Shipwatch. 01/19/10. Officers met with the victim who reported securing a bicycle on the bicycle racks, located in the parking garage area, underneath the condominium building. It was later discovered that the chain had been cut and the bicycle stolen by unknown person(s). Through investigation, a suspect has developed. The investigation continues.

**GRAND LARCENY.** Marsh Island Lane. 01/20/10. Victim reported that unknown person(s) had taken and carried away his concrete cutting saw without his knowledge or permission. The saw was located in the pawn system. Investigators recovered the stolen saw, valued at approximately \$1,000. A warrant was obtained for the subject that pawned the saw. The warrant has been entered into the National Crime Information Center (NCIC).

**GRAND LARCENY.** Shipwatch. 01/20/10. Victim reported that her luggage, camera and jewelry had been stolen from her rental unit. The stolen property was located in the pawn system and has been recovered by investigators. A warrant was obtained for the suspect, who was arrested on 01/26/10. All of the stolen property has been recovered and returned to the victim.
