Case Synopsis

**BURGLARY.** Charleston Boulevard. 01/31/10. Victim reported that keys to the residence had been unlawfully removed from the lockbox, and it appeared that a suspect had entered the residence. Although entry was made, the victim was unable to determine if any items had been stolen. The investigation continues.

**PETIT LARCENY.** Palmetto Drive. 01/29/10. Victim reported that unknown person(s) entered his workspace and took and carried away without his permission a Panasonic camcorder. The workspace is unsecured during business hours, which is during the suspected time-frame the property was stolen. The investigation continues.

**PETIT LARCENY.** Palm Boulevard. 01/27/10. Victim reported that unknown person(s) took and carried away his O'Neill wet suit that he had hung on a bicycle rack attached to his vehicle to dry. The investigation continues.

**GRAND LARCENY.** 01/26/10. During a follow-up investigation of a reported grand larceny of jewelry, investigators developed a suspect and obtained an arrest warrant. During an interview and interrogation of the suspect, a confession was obtained. The subject was transported to the Charleston County Detention Center. All of the jewelry was recovered and returned to the victim.
