

**Isle of Palms Police Department
Weekly Crime Report for February 1-7, 2010**

Case Synopsis

DOMESTIC DISPUTE. Carolina Boulevard. 02/01/2010. A couple, not living together, entered into a verbal altercation regarding the male half having an affair. Upon arrival, officers made contact with both the male and female, at which time the female (the rightful owner of the property) requested that officers make the male leave her residence, which he did without further incident.

PETIT LARCENY. Palmetto Boulevard. 02/05/2010. Victim reported that sometime between 08/01/09 and 02/03/10, unknown person(s) unlawfully entered into the "owner's closet" of the rental unit, taking and carrying away a power tool belonging to her and without her permission. The investigation continues.

GRAND LARCENY. Ocean Boulevard. 02/05/2010. Victim reported that while visiting the Isle of Palms, unknown person(s) took and carried away approximately \$3,600.00 worth of jewelry from the unit she rented while on vacation. The investigation continues.

AGGRAVATED ASSAULT. Ocean Boulevard. 02/07/2010. Officers were dispatched to the Windjammer in reference to a fight in progress. Upon arrival, a white male subject, found to be grossly intoxicated, was placed under arrest for Disorderly Conduct and additionally charged with Aggravated Assault for striking a Windjammer employee about the head and facial region with a beer bottle. The subject was transported to the Charleston County Detention Center.
