Case Synopsis

**DISORDERLY CONDUCT.** Ocean Boulevard. 03/28/10. Officers observed a white male subject urinating in a public area and placed the same under arrest.

**DRUNK PEDESTRIAN.** Ocean Boulevard. 03/27/10. An officer observed an individual leaving the Windjammer who appeared to be extremely intoxicated and carrying a beer in each hand. The officer made contact with the subject who was unstable on his feet and placed the same under arrest.

**TRESPASSER.** Morgan Place Drive and Palmetto Drive. 03/26/10. Officers were dispatched to the incident location and made contact with the complainant, Wild Dunes Security, in reference to two white, male subjects riding skateboards on the property. Officers identified the subjects and confirmed that they did not, in fact, live within the Wild Dunes Community. Subsequently, both subjects were placed on trespass notice and escorted from the property.
