Weekly Crime Report for March 29 – April 4, 2010

Case Synopsis

BURGLARY. 23rd Avenue. 04/04/10. Officers were dispatched to a possible breaking and entering that had already occurred. Upon arriving on scene, officers spoke with the victim/complainant who stated that on the report date, at approximately 2:15 PM, he noticed that the locks to his front door had been tampered with. Officers reported that there were physical manifestations of an attempted forced entry, in that both locks had an unknown object jammed into the key opening, causing the locks to widen and the tumblers to not turn. Additionally, officers reported to have observed two pry marks on the door frame next to each lock. The victim advised officers that nothing appeared to be missing from his residence and that he rarely uses the front door to the house and that this could have happened anytime this past week.

GRAND LARCENY. Palmetto Drive. 04/04/10. Victim reported to officers that he secured his bicycle in the garage area of the incident location on 04/03/10 and noticed that it had been taken and carried away on 04/04/10.

CRIMINAL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. Forest Trail. 04/03/10. Victim reported to officers that he and his wife had engaged in a verbal argument, and shortly thereafter, he entered the shower to get dressed for the day. The victim further stated that his wife entered the bathroom and the verbal altercation continued, resulting in her pushing him causing him to fall in the tub. The female subject was taken into custody and charged accordingly.
