

**Isle of Palms Police Department

Case Synopsis

**BURGLARY.** Seaside Cottage Lane. 05/10/10. Victim reported to officers that unknown person(s) entered into his rental property (incident location) and took and carried away numerous items, without his knowledge or consent. There were no indications of forced entry into the residence.

**PETIT LARCENY.** Cameron Boulevard. 5/10/10. Victim reported that she observed a Hispanic male, last seen driving a blue in color pick-up truck take and carry away items from her yard, without her knowledge or consent. Officers located the suspect and conducted a traffic stop upon the vehicle. The victims' property was located and returned.

**PETIT LARCENY.** 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue. 5/12/10. Victim reported that unknown person(s) took and carried away two planters with flowers from her front patio.

**MALICIOUS INJURY TO PROPERTY/VANDALISM.** 05/14/10. The night manager of the hotel reported that a white male subject, who appeared to be intoxicated and/or under the influence of narcotics, damaged hotel property by breaking large plant/tree pots, unearthing a number of signs which had been placed in the underneath parking area to direct guests to parking, etc, overturned and broke several cement ashtrays, and had broken several light fixtures. Officers and Investigators located the suspect, who was positively identified as the perpetrator, by witnesses and the complainant. The complainant advised officers that he would not to pursue charges, should the perpetrator pay restitution to the hotel for the damages, to which he (perpetrator) agreed.
