Case Synopsis

CRIMINAL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. Cameron Boulevard. 05/17/10. Victim reported that her husband was intoxicated when he returned home from playing golf, upon which time an argument ensued. During the argument, the suspect dumped the victims' purse and began throwing items, from the purse, at the victim, some of which struck the victim about the head and facial region. The suspect was placed under arrest and charged accordingly.

BURGLARY. Charleston Boulevard. 05/20/10. Victim reported that an unknown white male subject took and carried away a bicycle from within his enclosed garage. The subject was caught on surveillance cameras the victim has posted on both the interior and exterior of the residence. The video recordings have been turned over to the Criminal Investigations Division for forensic analysis and follow-up investigation.
