Case Synopsis

**CRIMINAL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.** Boardwalk Inn. 06/14/10. Victim reported that she and her husband had a verbal altercation regarding the amount of alcoholic beverages he had consumed during the day. The verbal altercation escalated to a physical attack, whereby her husband repeatedly shoved her against the wall of the bathroom and onto the floor. The victim stated that she was able to escape to the living room area, where her husband, then, shoved her numerous times onto the sofa. The physical altercation ended on the balcony, after she was thrown against the railings, as her husband threatened to throw her from the fourth floor balcony. Officers arrived on scene and detained the male subject.

**FRAUD.** 57th Avenue. 06/15/10. The victim reported that unknown person(s) utilized her credit card number to attempt to make a purchase at a business in New Jersey. The victim believes that her credit card number was obtained from the internet.
