Weekly Crime Report for July 12-18, 2010

Case Synopsis

BREACH OF TRUST. Palmetto Drive. 07/12/10. Victim reported that a quantity of cash and prescription medication had been taken and carried away from their rental unit, without her knowledge or consent, while she was at the beach. The case has been to the Criminal Investigations Division. As of date of this report, suspects have developed and arrest warrants are pending.

GRAND LARCENY. Fairway Oaks Lane. 07/12/10. Victim reported that approximately \$1,184.00 worth of her personal property, to include jewelry and cash, was stolen from her rental unit. The case has been assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division. Suspects have developed and the investigation is on-going at the time of this report.

PETIT LARCENY. Palmetto Drive. Victim reported that approximately \$900.00 worth of her personal property had been taken and carried away from her rental unit, without her knowledge or consent. The case has been assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division. Suspects and leads have developed and the case is in follow-up status at this time.

THEFT FROM A MOTOR VEHICLE. Ocean Boulevard. 07/13/10. Victim reported that unknown person(s) entered his unsecured vehicle, which had been parked in the front beach area at the time, and took and carried away his wallet, containing a quantity of cash, his passport, debit card, credit cards, Blackberry mobile telephone and a pair of Nike brand skater shoes.

PETIT LARCENY. Tabby Lane. 07/14/10. Victim reported that she had left four bicycles, unsecured, in the front of her residence for approximately two (2) weeks. Unknown person(s) took and carried away the bicycles without her knowledge or consent.

SWINDLE/FRAUD. Forest Trail. 07/15/10. The owner of the property advised officers that she was contacted by an individual who had seen her rental property posted on craigslist. The victim stated that she has not posted the property on craigslist. The case has been assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division.

UNDERAGE POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL. Grand Pavilion Boulevard. 07/16/10. Officers working a special assignment observed a number of individuals that appeared to be under the age of 21 consuming alcoholic beverages, after the same individuals had been asked to leave the pavilion pool area. The individuals were apprehended and charged accordingly.

GRAND LARCENY. Ocean Boulevard. 07/18/10. The victim reported to officers that while shopping at a local business, unknown person(s) took and carried away from her purse, her wallet containing a number of credit cards, a quantity of cash and her platinum and diamond wedding band (valued at approximately \$8,000). The case has been assigned to the Criminal Investigation Division.

BURGLARY. Charleston Boulevard. 07/18/10. The victim reported that unknown person(s) entered his garage area, through an unsecured door, and took and carried away a Trek Navigator Bicycle, with an approximate value of \$500.00.
