

**Isle of Palms Police Department

Case Synopsis

PETIT LARCENY. Red & White. 07/19/10. An employee of the Red & White reported to officers that he left his bicycle unsecured, while at work, during which time unknown person(s) took and carried away the same.

BURGLARY. Waterway Boulevard. 07/19/10. Victim reported to investigators that approximately \$4,000 worth of his personal property was taken and carried away, by unknown person(s), from the residence possibly through an unsecured garage door.
