

Isle of Palms Police Department
Weekly Crime Report for July 26 – August 1, 2010

Case Synopsis

VANDALISM. 3rd Avenue (On the Beach). 07/28/10. Officers were dispatched to the reporting incident location in reference to a fire on the beach. Upon investigation, it was determined that the subjects had removed portions of the fence of the unit they were renting to burn. The subjects were charged accordingly.

SIMPLE ASSAULT. Ocean Boulevard. 07/29/10. The victim reported that he and a friend were standing on the boardwalk at Dunescape when they were approached by a white male, who began talking to them. The third party became aggressive and struck the victim about the head and facial region with a closed-fist, then fled the scene on foot. The perpetrator was located several minutes after the incident. The perpetrator stated that the victim had pushed him a couple of times, which is why he assaulted him. Neither party wished to pursue charges.

UNDERAGE POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL. Grand Pavilion Boulevard. 07/31/10. On report date, an Investigator working an off-duty assignment at the Grand Pavilion (pool, boardwalk and beach area) observed a number of minors in possession of alcohol and beer. While identifying and charging the perpetrators, one of the individuals fled the scene on foot. Approximately one hour later, the subject was apprehended and charged accordingly. At the time he was located, the subject was in further violations: Illegal Transportation of Legal Liquor, Possession of a Fake ID, Possession of More Than One Driver's License (Belonging to Another). During interview, it was determined that the subject was one of the perpetrators of stealing a number of liter bottles of alcohol from the Grand Pavilion Bar on or about 07/28/10. The subject provided a confession and some of the stolen alcohol was recovered. The subject was additionally charged for the larceny, Minor in Possession of Beer, Resisting Arrest, Unlawful Littering on the Beach, No Alcohol on Beach or Streets and Unlawful Destruction of Dunes/Sea Oats.

Follow-Up Investigations

GRAND LARCENY. Original Report Date: 02/18/10. Case was assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division. Subject was arrested on Isle of Palms Police Department Warrant on 07/31/10. Approximately \$27,000 of stolen property was recovered. The arrest clears several Isle of Palms Police Department cases, as well as cases from other jurisdictions.

PETIT LARCENY. Original Report Date: 07/12/10. Case was assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division. Subject was arrested on Isle of Palms Police Department Warrant on 07/20/10. Approximately \$2,300 of stolen property was recovered. It is suspected that additional warrants for this subject are forthcoming for a number of additional violations that will close multiple cases.

PETIT LARCENY. Original Report Date: 07/13/10. Case was assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division. Subject was arrested on Isle of Palms Police Department Warrant on 07/20/10. Approximately \$1,000 of stolen property was recovered. It is suspected that additional warrants for this subject are forthcoming for a number of additional violations that will close multiple cases.
