

**Isle of Palms Police Department
Weekly Crime Report for August 2-8, 2010**

Case Synopsis

AGGRAVATED ASSAULT. Ocean Boulevard. 08/03/10. Officers responded to the Windjammer in reference to a call regarding a fight in progress with a weapon involved. Upon arrival, officers made contact with the victim who positively identified the perpetrator. Both the victim and perpetrator admitted that a verbal altercation over a game of pool escalated to a physical altercation and that the perpetrator had a knife in his possession at the time. The perpetrator claimed that he had been threatened in his career and that he felt fearful for his life at the time of this incident. The perpetrator was arrested and charged accordingly.

FRAUD. Ocean Boulevard. 08/03/10. Victim reported that her mobile telephone and a debit card had been stolen from the Windjammer. Before she could cancel the debit card, approximately \$200.00 worth of charges had posted to her account. The case has been assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division.

PETIT LARCENY. Grand Pavilion Boulevard. 08/04/10. The victim reported that a quantity of cash and several articles of clothing had been taken and carried away from her Wild Dunes rental unit during her visit. The case was assigned to the Criminal Investigations Unit. As of the date of this report, the items have been located and a suspect is being pursued. An arrest warrant will be forth coming.

PETIT LARCENY. Palmetto Drive. 08/05/10. The victim reported that her laptop computer had been taken and carried away from her rental unit without her knowledge or consent. The case was assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division. As of the date of this report, the property has been located and returned to the owner.

SUSPICIOUS CIRCUMSTANCES. Grand Pavilion Boulevard. 08/05/10. Complainant reported that a number of underage individuals were at the bar attempting to purchase alcoholic beverages, all of whom had been denied on several occasions. Officers arrived on scene and placed all of the individuals on Trespass Notice and escorted the same from the property.

PETIT LARCENY. 41st Avenue. 08/07/10. Officers were dispatched to the Isle of Palms Marina, where the victim stated that an unknown subject, who was still in the area, had just taken and carried away tools and lawn equipment from his storage shed. Officers were able to locate the subject, recover and return the stolen property to the victim. The subject was placed under arrest and charged accordingly.

UNDERAGE POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL. Grand Pavilion Boulevard. 08/08/10. An officer working in an off-duty capacity observed a number of underaged individuals consuming alcoholic beverages. All subjects were detained and charged accordingly.
