Case Synopsis

BURGLARY. 54th Avenue. 09/13/10. The victim reported to officers that unknown person(s) entered her unsecured, enclosed garage and took and carried away an irrigation system water pump.

WARRANT ARREST. J. C. Long Boulevard. 09/14/10. A suspect in an unrelated case met with Investigators for interview. A persons check produced information that the subject had an outstanding warrant with the Charleston County Sheriff's Office. The subject was, subsequently, arrested and turned over to the Charleston County Sheriff's Office.

SIMPLE ASSAULT. Waterway Boulevard. 09/16/10. Officers and Investigators responded to the incident location in reference to a fight in progress. Upon arrival, the subjects were separated, interviewed and treated for minor lacerations and contusions. The primary aggressor was determined and placed under arrest. The physical assault occurred as the result of primary aggressor continuously calling and harassing the victim. During the telephone calls, the primary aggressor threatened bodily harm upon the victim and thereafter, went to the victims' residence.

FORCIBLE RAPE. Ocean Boulevard (On the beach). 09/18/10. The victim reported that an acquaintance of hers sexually assaulted her. The investigation continues.
