

Isle of Palms Police Department
Weekly Crime Report for November 1-7, 2010

Case Synopsis

PETIT LARCENY. Palm Boulevard. 11/02/10. The victim, a representative from Elaine Brabham & Associates Real Estate, reported that two company signs were stolen from the front yard of the incident location.

BURGLARY. Palm Boulevard. 11/04/10. Officers responded to the incident location to a burglary that had already occurred. Upon arrival, Officers made contact with the homeowner who reported that he had hired a Painting Company to complete some minor renovations to his residence and allowed the same to store their equipment, including power tools, in his garage. When the company reported for work, on the report date, it was determined that unknown person(s) had entered the garage area and taken and carried away an undisclosed amount of tools.

BURGLARY. Ocean Boulevard. 11/04/10. The victim reported that she had stopped by her rental property, which is managed by Island Realty, just to check on residence. During the property check, the victim reported that unknown person(s) had taken and carried away four (4) painting prints and eight (8) decorative pillows. Approximate value of stolen property is \$1,200.

SUSPICIOUS CIRCUMSTANCES. Charleston Boulevard. 11/06/10. A juvenile reported that a white male and a white female, occupying a silver van, approached him and attempted to lure him inside the same. After refusing to get inside the van, the juvenile rode his bicycle to the Police Department to report the incident. Officers escorted the juvenile home and made contact with the parents to make them aware of the incident. Officers also patrolled the area in search of the aforementioned vehicle, with negative results. The suspect and vehicle descriptions were provided to neighboring jurisdictions.

BURGLARY. Linkside Court. 11/06/10. The victim reported that a number of items were stolen from within his secondary residence. Several items were in secured, locked closets within the residence with additional items being taken from a secured location in the garage. The entry doors to the secured locations had been forcefully entered.
