Case Synopsis

**BURGLARY** Seahorse Court. Report Date: 11/10/10. The victim responded to the Public Safety Building to report that unknown person(s) had entered her residence, and took and carried away a number of prescription medications. There were no indications of forced entry into the residence.

**PETIT LARCENY** Sparrow Drive. Report Date: 11/11/10. Officers responded in reference to the theft of a lawn mower. The victim stated that he had left the mower unattended, yet out of sight, for approximately 30 minutes during which time unknown person(s) entered his property and stole the same.

**DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE/HIT & RUN ACCIDENT** Palm Boulevard and Isle of Palms Connector. Report Date: 11/13/10. Officers responded to the intersection of Palm Boulevard and Connector in reference to a Hit and Run accident. The victim was able to provide suspect vehicle description, to include a South Carolina license plate. The license plate information provided the address of the registered owner. An Officer observed the suspect vehicle. After conducting a lawful traffic stop upon the suspect vehicle, the driver and sole occupant, was determined to be under the influence of alcohol. The suspect was placed under arrest and transported to the Charleston County Detention Center.
