

**Isle of Palms Police Department
Weekly Crime Report for November 15-21, 2010**

Case Synopsis

DOMESTIC DISPUTE - Sparrow Drive. Report Date: 11/19/10. Officers responded to the incident location in reference to a domestic dispute, in progress. Upon arrival, Officers observed a female subject standing in the middle of the roadway in a heated argument with a male subject in the front yard. Officers separated the parties and determined that the verbal altercation was in reference to the male subject spending time with other women. Both parties agreed that a physical altercation never occurred. The lack of physical manifestation of injury, on either subject, was congruent with their statements. The subjects do not cohabit, consequently, the female was advised to leave the residence and not return.

SUSPICIOUS CIRCUMSTANCES - Palm Boulevard. Report Date: 11/18/10. At approximately 9:30 p.m., an Investigator responded to the incident location in reference to suspicious circumstances. An unusual number of alarm activations had been received from the residence for short period of time, with no reported apparent reason for activations. The Investigator observed several exterior lights to be out while investigating a recent alarm and responded to the residence to check the lights. While on scene, the Investigator heard movement in the bushes on the northeast side of the residence and exited the screened porch area to investigate. When the Investigator lit the area with a flashlight, a subject who appeared to be wearing a dark-colored, hooded sweatshirt, approximately 6'0-6'3 in height, 185-200 lbs. fled the scene. The Investigator conducted a foot pursuit of the subject, through the dunes, and lost visual contact with the subject. Responding Officers conducted foot patrols in the area, and conducted field interviews with several subjects that met the general description. The residence was added to the Special Patrol List.

UNDERAGE POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL - Palmetto Drive. Report Date: 11/21/10. An Officer responded to the incident location in reference to a noise ordinance violation. While investigating the noise complaint, the Officer observed occupants of the suspect residence to be minors in the possession of alcoholic beverages. Two subjects were charged accordingly.
