Case Synopsis

BURGLARY Dunecrest Lane. Report Date: 11/22/10. The homeowner/victim reported that unknown subject(s) had entered his rental property and forcefully entered a locked owner's closet removing power tools and small electrical appliances.

AGGRAVATED ASSAULT Palm Boulevard. Report Date: 11/24/10. The victim advised reporting Officers that while walking to his vehicle, which was parked in the 200 block of Palm Boulevard, he dropped his mobile telephone and two unknown black male subjects physically assaulted when he stopped to pick up the phone. The perpetrators were both described as approximately 6'0", medium build and wearing dark clothing and jeans. One of the two subjects had long hair in dread-locks. During the assault, the unknown subjects took and carried away the victims' iPhone.

PETIT LARCENY Palmetto Drive. Report Date: 11/27/10. Victim reported that unknown person(s) took and carried away his 26 inch, gray in color, Trek Navigator bicycle from a bike rack located on Shipwatch property. The victim was able to provide a serial number for the bicycle which was entered into the stolen property database of the National Crime Information Center (NCIC).

PETIT LARCENY Grand Pavilion Boulevard. Report Date: 11/28/10. Victim reported that two bicycles were stolen from the parking garage of the Boardwalk Inn. A suspect has developed and one of the stolen bicycles has been recovered. The investigation continues.
