

**Isle of Palms Police Department

Case Synopsis

**PETIT LARCENY** Report Date: 12/06/10. The victim reported that a verbal altercation transpired between himself and an employee (suspect), regarding the employee's work. After the altercation, the employee departed from the scene in his (the employee's) vehicle, which had the victim's boat trailer attached. Shortly thereafter, the suspect telephoned the victim to advise that he was keeping the victim's trailer until the victim paid him for his work.

**BREACH OF TRUST** Report Date: 12/10/10. The victim reported that he suspected his housekeeper of stealing his prescribed Oxycodone for, at least, the past three months. As a result, he placed 10 dosage units of Oxycodone in an old prescription bottle prior to leaving his residence, on the scheduled day his housekeeper was to arrive. When he returned home, the housekeeper was still at the residence and half of the pills were missing.

**SIMPLE POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA** Report Date: 12/11/10. While on routine patrol in the 3800 block of Palm Boulevard, an Officer observed a number of traffic violations committed by the driver of the vehicle traveling directly in front of the Officer. After conducting a lawful traffic stop on the suspect vehicle, the Officer detected a strong smell of marijuana coming from within the vehicle. The driver of the vehicle provided consent for a search of the vehicle, at which time the Officer located a quantity of marijuana. The perpetrator was arrested and charged accordingly.
