Case Synopsis

GRAND LARCENY Report Date: 12/13/10. Victim reported that unknown person(s) forced entry into his locked trailer and took and carried away a Mercury outboard boat motor and two wooden boat paddles. On 12/14/10, Investigators located the stolen property at a North Charleston pawn shop. Consequently, the stolen property was recovered and returned to the victim. An arrest warrant is pending for the suspect.

SIMPLE ASSAULT Report Date: 12/15/10. Officers were dispatched to a residence on Hartnett Boulevard in reference to an assault. The assault occurred between family members, neither of whom wished to pursue charges. However, the involved parties agreed to separate for the remainder of the day.

THEFT FROM A MOTOR VEHICLE Report Date: 12/16/10. The victim reported that unknown person(s) entered his unlocked vehicle and took and carried away his Dell laptop computer.

HARASSMENT Report Date: 12/19/10. Officers responded to the incident location, on Hartnett Boulevard, in reference to harassment. The victim advised Officers that he had hosted a party earlier in the evening on the report date. Several hours after the party, a neighbor responded to his residence and became hostile with the victim, accusing guests of the party of illegal parking and littering. The victim and responding Officers checked the complaining neighbors' yard, finding no refuse. Approximately one hour later, Officers responded to the complaining neighbor's residence in reference to vandalism. Unknown person(s) had thrown a quantity of eggs at his residence, one of which broke a window of the residence.
