

**Isle of Palms Police Department

Case Synopsis

PETIT LARCENY Report Date: 12/20/10. Officers responded to The Villages in Wild Dunes in reference to the theft of bicycle parts. The part that was removed and carried away by unknown person(s) is valued at \$130.00.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT Report Date: 12/21/10. Officers responded to the Windjammer in reference to a disturbance. It was learned that a grossly intoxicated white female patron had caused a verbal altercation, just prior to the arrival of Officers, and had behaved in a belligerent manner on several occasions throughout the evening. The subject was placed under arrest and charged accordingly.

CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT (RAPE) Report Date: 12/21/10. The Police Department received a telephone complaint from an employee of a local medical/counseling facility in reference to a rape that occurred at an unknown location on the front beach in late October of 2010. The investigation continues.

BURGLARY Report Date: 12/22/10. The victim reported that several of his power tools were stolen from underneath his residence, on Yacht Harbor Drive, while he was out of town.

THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE Report Dates: 12/22/10 and 12/23/10. Unknown person(s) entered into the victim's vehicles, taking and carrying away a number of electronic items from one location, and cash from a second location, both on Hartnett Boulevard. Investigators have developed a lead and believe that the same perpetrator committed both offenses. The investigation continues.

BURGLARY Report Date: 12/24/10. Officers met with a rental company representative regarding the theft of a number of televisions from a rental residence. Investigators have developed and are pursuing leads in this case.
