Case Synopsis

BURGLARY Report Date: 12/27/10. Unknown person(s) entered into the Isle of Palms Recreation Department and vandalized the restroom facilities, during the nighttime. Investigators are conducting a follow-up investigation regarding possible leads.

VANDALISM Report Date: 12/29/10. While on routine patrol, an Officer observed an open door on a vehicle parked in the driveway of a rental residence, on Beachside Drive. Upon further investigation, Officers observed a white male subject in close proximity to the residence, which had just been vandalized. Subsequently, the subject was placed under arrest and charged accordingly.

SIMPLE POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA Report Date: 12/31/10. Officers responded to an address on Forest Trail, in reference to assisting the Department of Social Services in investigating an alleged case of child abuse. While speaking with the female suspect, Isle of Palms Police Department Telecommunications confirmed an active warrant for the female subject, out of the North Charleston Police Department. Upon detaining the subject, she admitted to Officers to being in the possession of marijuana.

PETIT LARCENY Report Date: 12/31/10. The victim reported that unknown person(s) took, and carried away, his bicycle from the Harbor Course Pro Shop during the short time he left it unsecured while inside the business.

BURGLARY Report Date: 01/02/11. The victim reported to Officers that unknown person(s) entered into his enclosed, yet unsecured garage and took, and carried away, his golf clubs.
