Case Synopsis

**THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE** Report Date: 01/01/11. The victim reported to Officers that she had parked her vehicle in the 1000 block of Ocean Boulevard. While away from her vehicle, unknown person(s) entered into her unlocked vehicle and took her wallet from the front seat.

**PETIT LARCENY** Report Date: 01/12/10. Officers responded to Island Laundry and met with the victim who stated that she left her wallet at the laundry while she left the same to go to lunch. When she returned to the laundry, the victim discovered that unknown person(s) had stolen her wallet.

**SIMPLE ASSAULT** Report Date: 01/17/11. Officers were dispatched to Ocean Boulevard in reference to a fight in progress, with possible weapons. Upon arrival, two of the three individuals involved had fled the scene. Officers were able to locate all parties, none of whom had any observable physical manifestations of injury. The victim did not wish to pursue charges.

**INVESTIGATIONS UPDATE:** Investigators have made arrests in a burglary and a larceny that was reported earlier this month. Both incidents occurred on Morgan Place Drive. Additionally, Investigators have developed suspects in the Ocean Point Drive vehicle breaking and entering/larcenies and burglaries, which were also reported on or about 01/09/11. Warrants have been obtained for a subject that allegedly committed the offense of Criminal Sexual Conduct at a residence on Fairway Dunes Drive.
