

Isle of Palms Police Department
Weekly Crime Report for January 17-23, 2011

Case Synopsis

BURGLARY 01/17/11. The victim reported to Officers that he had left his residence on Carolina Boulevard for a short period of time, on the incident date. Upon his return, discovered that unknown person(s) had entered the residence through a glass door and took, and carried away approximately \$2, 700 worth of his property.

NARCOTICS ARREST 01/19/11. On report date, an Officer conducting routine patrol in the area of the Isle of Palms Connector observed a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed. After conducting a lawful traffic stop upon the same, and placing the driver under arrest for operating the vehicle while uninsured; discovered a quantity of a controlled substance (Schedule II) and marijuana. The defendant was charged accordingly and transported to the Charleston County Detention Center.

VANDALISM 01/23/11. Officers responded to Forest Trail in reference to a complaint of vandalism. Upon arrival, Officers observed a “No Parking” sign vandalized by anti-Semitic graffiti.

INVESTIGATIONS UPDATE: Investigators are still pursuing leads that have developed the possible identification of suspects involved in the Ocean Point incidents, as well as a vandalism that occurred on 28th Avenue. Additionally, Investigators have developed suspects in a Breaking and Entering to a Motor Vehicle incident that occurred on the Front Beach last week.
