Case Synopsis

VANDALISM Report Date: 02/01/11. The victim met with an Officer at the Public Safety Building to report vandalism that had occurred to his vehicle. The victim stated that sometime between 01/31/11 and 02/01/11, unknown person(s) damaged an exterior mirror on his vehicle while the same was parked in the drive of his 32nd Avenue residence.

SIMPLE ASSAULT Report Date: 02/06/11. While patrolling the Front Beach area in search of a suspicious person, Officers were flagged down by a white female in front of the Windjammer. The female requested that Officers standby at the Windjammer with her while she searched for her wallet because she and her boyfriend had just had an altercation at his residence on J. C. Long Boulevard, and she was fearful that he would come looking for her. The female stated that the verbal altercation escalated into a physical altercation when her boyfriend pushed her, causing her to fall down a flight of stairs. Officers inquired as to whether or not the victim was injured, to which she responded that during the fall her arm was injured, but she emphatically denied medical treatment. Officers attempted to make contact with the male subject at his residence, with negative findings. The victim stated that she did not wish to pursue charges. Officers provided contact information for the Criminal Investigations Division, as well as the Victim Advocate, in the event she decided otherwise.
