Case Synopsis

WELFARE CHECK Report Date: 02/07/11. A female subject contacted the Isle of Palms Police Department to request that an Officer respond to an address on Marsh Island Drive in reference to a welfare check on her boyfriend. The female complainant stated that she had received text messages from her boyfriend that contained suicidal ideologies. Officers made contact with the male subject who denied any intent to harm himself or anyone else. There were no indications to lead Officers to take further action.

TRAFFIC OFFENSE Report Date: 02/10/11. While conducting routine patrol in the area of Palm Boulevard and 28th Avenue, a vehicle backed out of a driveway, in an erratic manner, almost striking the Officer's vehicle. Upon conducting a lawful traffic stop on the vehicle, an empty 12-pack of Busch Beer was located. The driver of the vehicle was charged accordingly.

TRAFFIC ARREST/DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE Report Date: 02/12/11. At approximately 12:41 p.m., an Officer was conducting routine patrol in the area of Palm Boulevard at Charleston Boulevard when the Officer observed a vehicle traveling in the wrong lane of traffic, causing the Officer to take evasive action to avoid a collision. Upon conducting a lawful traffic stop on the vehicle, the driver of the vehicle voluntarily submitted to Field Sobriety Tasks, which she could not perform. The subject was taken into custody and after refusing to provide a breath sample, was transported to the Charleston County Detention Center where she was booked for DUI.
