Case Synopsis

**BURGLARY** Report Date: 02/14/11. The property manager of a rental property located in the 3300 block of Palm Boulevard reported that unknown person(s) had entered the residence, without his consent or knowledge. Evidence located at the scene indicated that the perpetrator(s) had stayed at the residence for an unknown amount of time, in that the shower, linens, and dishes had been used. Burnt food items and pans were discovered in the kitchen, along with a burnt broom. A fire extinguisher had been discharged with the contents covering both the upstairs and downstairs areas.

**PETIT LARCENY** Report Date: 02/15/11. The victim reported that an acquaintance of hers took and carried away an article of clothing from her residence, without her permission.

**SUSPICIOUS CIRCUMSTANCES** Report Date: 02/19/11. Officers responded to the beach in the 900 block of Ocean Boulevard in reference to suspicious circumstances. Upon arrival, Officers met with the complainant/witness who reported that an unknown white male, approximately 30 years old, 6'00" tall, 225 lbs., with brown hair, attempted to steal a purse that was left unattended. After being confronted by the witness, the subject dropped the purse and fled the scene.
