Case Synopsis

THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE Report Date: 03/01/11. The victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into his vehicle, which was parked in the driveway of his 30th Avenue residence, and stole his iPod.

BURGLARY Report Date: 03/04/11. The victim reported that unknown person(s) took and carried away a roll of copper tubing from the residence. Suspects have developed and leads are being pursued by Investigators.

PETIT LARCENY Report Date: 03/05/11. Unknown person(s) entered the porch area of a residence in the 2700 block of Palm Boulevard and stole lawn furniture and a trash receptacle.

POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA Report: 03/06/1. An Officer conducted a lawful traffic stop in the 2100 block of Palm Boulevard. While speaking with the driver, the sole occupant of the vehicle, the Officer detected a strong odor of recently burnt marijuana emitting from within the vehicle. A search of the vehicle produced a quantity of a green, plant-like material which field-tested presumptive positive for tetrahydrocannabinol (THC). Subsequently, the driver was placed under arrest and charged accordingly.

PETIT LARCENY Report Date: 03/06/11. The street identification signs for Palm Boulevard and 55th Avenue were unlawfully removed, and taken and carried away by unknown person(s).
