Case Synopsis

DISORDERLY CONDUCT Report Date: 03/07/11. While on routine patrol of the Front Beach area, an Officer observed two individuals sitting in a parked vehicle engaged in intimate behavior. The Officer made contact with the individuals at which time he determined that both subjects had consumed a quantity of alcoholic beverages. The subjects were placed under arrest and charged, accordingly.

HARASSING TELEPHONE CALLS Report Date: 03/09/11. The victim reported that she has been receiving a telephone calls and text messages from an ex-boyfriend, whom she has informed that she no longer wishes to have contact with him. Further, the subject has continuously left gifts on the victims' doorsteps and has followed her to businesses in the Town of Mount Pleasant.

MALICIOUS INJURY TO PROPERTY/TRESPASSING Report Date: 03/12/11. Wild Dunes Security observed three subjects on Yacht Harbor Drive, in the area of The Moorings, behaving in a suspicious manner. Upon further investigation, it was determined that one of the three subjects had vandalized a vehicle parked in the parking lot of The Moorings, by shooting the tail lamp with a B. B. gun.
