

**Isle of Palms Police Department

Case Synopsis

November 21: Monday

Unknown person(s) entered into an unsecured vehicle parked in the drive of a rental residence. The victim reported that several pieces of expensive jewelry, some electronics and several bottles of prescription medication were stolen.

November 22: Tuesday

The Isle of Palms Police Department Dispatch Center received a call from a victim who stated that an unknown subject had pointed and presented a firearm at him as a result of an incident of road rage. The perpetrator was located and charged accordingly.

November 23: Wednesday

Officers met with victims at their second residence, which is also a rental property. The victims reported that several screens had been removed from the windows and a number of other screens had been cut. However, it did not appear that entry was made into the residence. The property manager stated that the last renters may be responsible for the damage.
