Case Synopsis

**December 19: Monday**

Officers met with a victim who reported that his surfboard had been stolen from his residence. Through further investigation, it was determined that the surfboard has been missing since the victim's roommate moved out. The case has been assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division.

**December 20: Tuesday**

An Officer conducting route patrol of the area of 41<sup>st</sup> Avenue and Palm Boulevard conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle after observing a seatbelt violation. A check of the operator's driver's license through the Department of Motor Vehicles database produced information that the license was suspended due to failure to maintain vehicle insurance. The driver was placed under arrest and charged accordingly.

**December 22: Thursday**

A victim reported that while attending a holiday party at a local establishment, unknown person(s) stole his wallet and mobile telephone from his jacket pocket. A second report of petit larceny was filed with the Police Department on 12/27/11 by an individual that was in attendance at the same party. The second victim reported that her purse, containing her mobile telephone, had been stolen. After tracking a telephone call made on the second victim's mobile phone, a suspect has developed. Both cases have been assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division.
