Case Synopsis

February 9: Thursday

An officer on route patrol of the area of Palm Boulevard and 14th Avenue observed a vehicle disregard the traffic light. After conducting a traffic stop on the vehicle and speaking with the driver, the officer observed an open container of alcoholic beverage sitting in the center console. The driver was placed under arrest and transported to the Charleston County Detention Facility.
