

**Isle of Palms Police Department

Case Synopsis

March 13: Tuesday

A victim reported that he had made arrangements to rent a condo in Lagoon Villas, to include paying the \$1,400.00 booking fee, on Craig's List. After the victim paid the booking fee through his PayPal account, he attempted to contact the renter with no response. The victim was able to locate the condo's owner, who advised that the unit is not a rental nor has she ever listed it as so on Craig's List.

March 15: Thursday

An Officer conducting routine patrol in the area of 36th Avenue and Palm Boulevard observed a seatbelt violation. After conducting a traffic stop on the vehicle, it was discovered that the operator of the vehicle did not possess a driver's license and did not have her 8-month-old child secured in a safety seat. She was charged accordingly.

March 17: Saturday

Officers responded to Seagrass Lane in reference to a domestic dispute. Upon arrival, the Officers did not observe any disturbance occurring at the time. Contact was made with the complainant who stated that her parents were in a verbal altercation at the time she called the police department, and she was afraid that the argument would escalate into a physical altercation. Both parties involved in the verbal altercation confirmed that it did not.
