

Isle of Palms Police Department
Weekly Crime Report for May 14 – May 20, 2012

Case Synopsis

May 14: Monday

Public Intoxication: Palm Boulevard. A taxi driver informed an Officer that his fare could not provide an address at which to be dropped off. Upon speaking with the suspect, the Officer concluded that the suspect was too intoxicated to care for himself and placed the suspect under arrest; the suspect was booked into Charleston County Jail.

May 15: Tuesday

Petit Larceny: Pelican Reach. Victim reported that two (2) checks, a New York tax return check for \$886 and a USA tax return check for \$1000 were stolen from her residence on 05/08/2012 while repair work was occurring.

May 16: Wednesday

Fraud: Carolina Boulevard. Victim reported that he had paid a pool company \$10,839.00 on 04/13/2012 to purchase parts to complete the second half of the installation of a pool. No parts or labor have resulted from this payment. The pool company was contacted, and they stated that not all parts were in and they would be finishing the work within a week.

May 17: Thursday

Motor Vehicle Theft: 57th Avenue. Victim reported that her EZ Go golf cart had been stolen from the 57th Avenue beach path. Later the victim called and advised that the golf cart had been taken by an elderly suspect by accident and returned it to her residence later in the evening.

May 18: Friday

Motor Vehicle Breaking & Entering: Carolina Blvd. Six (6) reported thefts from vehicles were reported that occurred between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Entry was made into unsecured vehicles where the suspect(s) would remove wallets, purses, and electronics, and CDs. Suspects were going through stolen items as they traveled from Palm and Carolina, throwing discarded property onto roadway and placing wanted items in hidden areas to be picked up later. Property was located from Palm Boulevard to the Mt. Pleasant side of Hwy 517. No credit cards or other security cards were taken; cash was removed from some items, while left in others. A bicycle was also taken from the area.

May 19: Saturday

Alcohol Violation: Ocean Boulevard. An Officer observed a suspect with an open container walking on the sidewalk; Officer issued a PR citation for open container.

Assist other Police Department: Goat Island. IOP dispatch received a call of gunshots on Goat Island; Charleston County Sheriff's Office requested an officer to assist a deputy in the investigation. An investigation by both departments showed that subjects were target practicing on the island; no law enforcement action required.

May 20: Sunday

Petit Larceny: Sea Grass Lane. Victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole six goldfish from his outdoor pond in his backyard.
