Case Synopsis

**May 28: Monday**

Breaking and Entering Auto: Palm Boulevard. Victim reported that unknown suspect/s entered and removed a purse from her vehicle; the purse contained cash and several credit cards.

**May 29: Tuesday**

Fraud: Lagoon Villas. Victim reported an internet fraud from a Craig's List posting for a summer rental unit. On arrival, victim learned that the unit had not been posted by owner or was the unit for rent.

Burglary and Breaking and Entering Auto: Cameron Boulevard. Victim reported that unknown suspect/s attempted to enter residence through a sliding glass door (no entry made); victim also reported unknown suspect/s entered a vehicle on property and stole a GPS and gas from the vehicle's tank.
